Resolution #3-2022/2023

A Resolution to Approve Additional Disbursement of Funds for the American Rescue Plan Act

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the \$109 trillion American Rescue Plan Act, and

WHEREAS, Grundy County applied for and has received the first tranche of funds for the American Rescue Plan Act totaling \$1,187,961.50, and

WHEREAS, the Grundy County Board of Supervisors has reviewed additional requests and determined those that will qualify for the American Rescue Plan Act, and

WHEREAS, based on the distribution guidelines from the U. S. Department of Treasury, the following projects have been approved for the use of American Rescue Plan Act funds:

Purchase blinds for the recorder's office and the office of the clerk of court in an amount not to exceed \$3,000

Purchase Karpel software for county attorney in an amount not to exceed \$20,650

Purchase Microsoft Office 365 in an amount not to exceed \$45,955

Purchase bottle fillers for the Grundy County Heritage Museum, County Engineer's Office, and annex building in an amount not to exceed \$3,000

Replace radios for secondary road employees in an amount not to exceed \$67,000

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Grundy County Board of Supervisors endorses the disbursement of American Rescue Plan Act funds for the items listed above and authorizes the County Auditor to make these payments as they are presented.
