The Grundy County Board of Supervisors met in special session on January 4, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. The meeting was called to order by Mary L. Schmidt, County Auditor, with the following members present: Riekena, Schildroth, Smith, Bakker, and Ross.

The County Auditor requested nominations for the offices of Chairman and Vice-Chairman.

Ross nominated Mark A. Schildroth for Chairman and Barbara L. Smith for Vice-Chairman, seconded by Bakker. Bakker moved that nominations cease and that a unanimous ballot be cast for Schildroth and Smith, seconded by Riekena. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Riekena and seconded by Ross to adjourn to the regular meeting. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Smith and seconded by Ross to introduce Resolution #24-2009/2010. A resolution authorizing the County Auditor to issue warrants in vacation of the Board.
