

RESOLUTION #17-2013/2014

WHEREAS: The Grundy County Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of the Code of Iowa to impose weight limitations on highway structures under their jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Grundy County Board of Supervisors that the following structures be posted at their listed load limits.

- Bridge located near NW Corner, Sec. 35-87-17, Palermo Township, (K-12) - New Posting Load - 417, 527, 630 Ton
- Bridge located near W1/4 Corner, Sec. 19-87-17, Palermo Township, (K-09) - New Posting Load - 415, 521, 625 Ton
- Bridge located near Center Corner, Sec. 34-86-17, Clay Township, (N-23) - New Posting Load - 6 Ton

AND the following structures previously restricted load limits have been removed due to repair or replacement:

- Bridge located near NE Corner Sec. 11-86-17, Clay Township, (N-7) - New Posting - Legal
- Bridge located near NE Corner Sec. 28-87-18, Melrose Township, (L-11) - New Posting - Legal

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.
