A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF GRUNDY COUNTY, IOWA ADOPTING A LOBBY POLICY GOVERNING THE LOBBYING OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT PERSONNEL AND/OR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PERSONNEL

LOBBY POLICY

The following is the policy of Grundy County, Iowa:

- No Community Development Block Grant Funds, HOME Investment Partnership Program Funds, or Department of Commerce funds under the control of, or funds distributed to Grundy County, lowa shall be spent to influence of attempt to influence a federal official;
- Any person or firm representing Grundy County, Iowa, who desires to, or is hired to, lobby for Grundy County, Iowa, with non-CDBG, non-HOME, or non-EDA funds is required to notify said intent to Grundy County, Iowa, and is required to file a "Disclosure Form to Report Lobbying";
- Any person or firm representing Grundy County, Iowa, who desires to, or is hired to, lobby for Grundy County, Iowa, with non-CDBG, non-HOME, or non-EDA funds is required to notify said intent to Grundy County, Iowa, and is required to obtain a certification of compliance by the state;
- 4. Persons who make expenditures to influence a HUD or EDA officer or employee in the award of financial assistance or taking of a management action by the department must keep records, and report to HUD or EDA on the expenditures; and
- 5. Persons who are retained to influence a HUD or EDA officer or employee in the award of financial assistance or in the taking of a management action by the department must register with HUD or EDA, and report to HUD or EDA on their lobbying activities.
