- 1. The meeting was convened by Commissioner Beyer at 9:00 a.m.

- 7. Buck currently has 7 active disability claims, 2 pensions and 3 trust funds she is working on.
- 8. Commissioner James reported receiving a call form the office of the ombudsman regarding a complaint filed by Mr. Richard Ahlberg. Mr. Ahlberg is concerned about not receiving services from GCVA due to a situation with him and Buck stemming from a city council issue. James assured the ombudsman that he is aware of the situation and Buck is professional and impartial and would assist Mr. Ahlberg in her role as veterans service officer.
- 9. During the discussion regarding the office being closed due to vacation and an in person training the topic of hiring a temporary part time person to be in the office occasionally came up. Beyer asked whether a recent sports physical would fulfill the county requirement of having a physical before employment. Buck will ask if that would work.
- 10. At 9:35 Beyer made a motion and James seconded that the commission entered into a closed session to discuss a relief application. The application was discussed and at 9:50 Huber made a motion and Beyer seconded to end the closed session.
- 11. Huber made a motion to approve the relief application, second from James and all were in favor.
- 12. The meeting was adjourned at 10:05.
